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PROGRAM NOTES

Ukrainian composer **Mykola Dmytrovich Leontovych** (1877-1921) created a choral work called *Shchedryk*, first performed by students at Kiev University in December 1916. The work is based on an old Slavic legend: at midnight on the night Jesus was born, every bell in the world rang out in celebration.

Today, the simple but joyous melody of "Carol of the Bells" is the best-known portion of the larger choral work and has become a holiday staple all over the world.

Performance Suggestions



* m. 27: "Ring-Hook-Damp". Pick up the B5/D6 cluster with the left hand. Ring only the D6, then transfer D6 to hang from the little finger of the right hand. Set down the D6 onto the table to damp it.

Meanwhile, pick up G#6 as a secondary in the left hand. (B5/G#6)
